Preface

What Jesus did Matt 4:23 Luke 7:21-22

Mat 4:23-24 And Yeshua was traveling about in all Galilee and he taught in their assemblies and was preaching The Gospel of the Kingdom and curing every sickness and disease among the people.

Mat 4:24 And his fame was heard in all Syria, and they brought to him all those who had become ill with various diseases, those who were afflicted with severe pain, and the demon possessed, and lunatics and paralytics, and he healed them.*

Luk 7:21 But in that hour, he healed many from diseases and from plagues and of evil spirits, and he gave sight to many blind people.

Luk 7:22 And Yeshua answered and he said to them, "Go tell Yohannan everything that you have seen and that you have heard; that they who were blind are seeing, and they who were lame are walking, and they who were lepers are cleansed, and they who were deaf are hearing, and they who were dead are raised, and those who were poor are given Good News."

Mar 16:18 And they will take up snakes, and if they should drink lethal poison, it will not harm them, and they will place their hands on the sick and they will be healed.

(This is in all but 5 of the oldest manuscripts)

His comment Ju 14: 15

Joh 14:15 If you love me, keep my commandments.

Nowhere has He rescinded these comments

If you are not following His example and doing what He said to do How can you say you are His follower or be His representative

There are only absolutes in the Bible do them or suffer the consequences of not doing them. God does not compromise neither should you.

God's advice on how to do it is found w 2 Tm 2:2 Train a small group and send them out to train small groups of others



You are a steward of the people under you and will be judged for the stewardship of them as well as what you taught them.

You will be judged by Jesus when you die for how wholeheartedly you did this.

Trying and failing is not a problem.\

Not trying wholeheartedly or compromising or reasonings to justify your attitude is.

God does not care about the results you if you wholeheartedly tried to do His Will. He is more concerned with the attitudes you have when you do His work.

You may be asked to do something you will fail at because God needs it done to use it to help His purposes or judge another person and if you have wholeheartedly done the Will of God, even though you fail, He will consider you a faithful servant.

A masterpiece of Satan

In Acts 6 we have the following”

Act 6:1-4 And in those days, when the number of the disciples was multiplied, there arose a murmuring of the Grecians against the Hebrews, because their

widows were neglected in the daily ministrations. Then the twelve called the multitude of the disciples unto them, and said, It is not reason that we should leave the word of God, and serve tables.

Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business. But we will give ourselves continually to prayer, and to the ministry of the word.

Satan has convinced the church that the minister runs everything but The Bible does not teach that. So, ministers spend time on things others should be doing and not doing what The Bible says they should be doing so that they are not using this time to ask The Holy Spirit what the church needs to hear preached.

Appreciating God

Unless we really appreciate what God has done for us and the Love behind it how can we wholeheartedly love Him in return and show it by our loving service of Him.

Salvation is a love relationship with The Father as our spiritual Father and The Lord Jesus as our step brother. Is that any way to treat close relatives who have done so much for you?

And of course, minister, you are to be the example in this as you are the leader of the people God has given you to train for Him.

We will all face judgment

One of the most sobering thoughts we can have is the realisation that we must face Jesus and give an account of the stewardship of our life and of those He sent to us to minister too.

On His heart is always the salvation of people so of primary interest will be our stewardship of the Great Commission and He will also be interested to see our efforts at carrying out the part about making disciples.

Then He will be interested about how we carried out our stewardship of the things He gave us: our life, family, employment ministering and how we interacted with other Christians.

Of primary concern will be how we expressed His Love to the unsaved let alone other Christians.

He said, that if we examined our lives to see if we lived in the way He desires us, too we would not be judged

So, we need to carefully examine all we do so that we will escape condemnation by Jesus for the bad stewardship of our life

Why Christians go to hell

This section focuses on why people who call themselves Christians go to hell.

This topic 'of why Christians go to hell' is not mentioned in churches. It is almost as if Satan stops this being preached so people will go to hell doing things, they do not realise will take them there.

There are four main reasons people go to hell and I have determined these from what Jesus told people when He took them to hell and showed people in hell who called themselves 'Christians' and from the reason He gave why many Christians will not go up in the rapture.

According to Revelation 3:5 and Hebrews 6:6-8 you can lose your salvation

Rev 3:5 He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

(Heb 6:4) For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost,

(Heb 6:5) And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come,

(Heb 6:6) If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame.

The following sins have been told by Jesus to others as the reasons many Christians are in hell.

These are:

Deliberately disobeying a law of God. Good examples are: deliberately disobeying the laws of the land, deliberately speeding, and not obeying the speed limits, deliberately not declaring the correct income for tax purposes. Anything that deliberately disobeys the laws of the land that do not contradict the Laws of God. We are told to give to God what is His and to the government what is theirs because He has allowed the government to be in charge of you.

God has allowed the government we have so we must give them respect when they do not ask us to do anything that is against the Law of God

Unforgiveness or Not wanting to reconcile with someone you have offended when you can do it (this is because you have not forgiven them unless because it is dangerous to attempt the reconciliation). Remember you must still want to reconcile even though you are not able too. God looks at your attitudes and not the result of what you do. He will tell you what to do about the situation if you want to know,

This is why Jesus said

Mat 5:23 Therefore if thou bring thy gift to the altar, and there rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee;

Mat 5:24 Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift.

Mat 5:23 (CFEV) So if you are about to place your gift on the altar and remember that someone is angry with you,

Mat 5:24 leave your gift there in front of the altar. Make peace with that person, then come back and offer your gift to God.

So as long as you wholeheartedly try to obey God it does not matter if you fail because your attitude is correct and Calvary has dealt with the effects of sin at the Cross. God does not look at your results but at the attitudes you did them in.

Anger that is not against the abuse of The King, His things, and His Kingdom,

Unrepentant sin: The refusing to stop doing something you know is wrong because you like doing it so much.

What about things classified as sin that you did not know you did.

Can they send you to hell?

Sin is deliberate rebellion against God and His Laws so if you did not know it was wrong then it is not considered rebellion. So, sins done without knowledge they are sin do not send you to hell unless you keep doing them once you know they are wrong.

Not having a personal relationship with Jesus and The Father

In John 17:3 we are told that eternal life is having an intimate relationship with The Father and Jesus and not just calling Him Lord. The demons call Jesus Lord but do not have salvation as they are not in an intimate relationship with Him and The Father.

This is because God is merciful and not a legalist and His Grace allows Him to overlook sins not deliberately committed against Him.

The Commands of Jesus

These are not negotiable and there is no way around them. Do them or face the consequences

Love is the main Command

The requirement to love as God loves is first expressed in the 10 Commandments which are all about the expression of Gods quality of Love.

Toward God

Toward others

Toward what He gives us to be a steward of which, includes our body.

Sin is given various names but in reality it is really just deliberately contravening one of these expressions of God's quality of Love.

Satan can only distract or deceive you and when you are not expressing God's Love this is what you are actually doing.

There is a list of seven deadly sins:

Pride, envy, wrath, gluttony, lust, sloth, and greed.

But these are not found in The Bible but were listed by Pope Gregory in the sixth century.

The only real command of Jesus is to love others as God loves them, which is found in Jn 13:34-35. If you do this you will do what God desires done which Jesus expressed through the other commands He gave which are all an expression of God's love for people which we should express to others in all that we do.

So, when you love something more than God you are breaking a way God expresses Love.

Sin is defined as deliberately not meeting a requirements of love to another (which includes God) or not Looking after what God gives us to care for Him. (which includes us as we are a property of God).

So, make a the list of sins you if want too, but remember behind every sin is deliberately doing something that does not express God's love In some correct way.

They are expressed in many ways and here are some of the main on es:

The commands of Jesus as they are usually quoted

(Peshitta) Joh 6:28 And they were saying to him, "What shall we do to work the service of God?"

(CEV) Jesus answered, "God wants you to have faith in the one he sent."

(KJV) Joh 6:28 Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God?

(DRB) Jesus answered and said to them: This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he hath sent.

The Disciples asked Jesus what they had to do to serve God. He replied that they had to believe in whom Jesus was which means you need to obey what He commanded as well as everything else The Bible says about Him and what He said.

Jesus gave the following commands to His disciples. If they do not apply to us it leads to the ridiculous scenario that we do not have to tell people about Jesus and all that He did was limited to his own generation. It also means we are at the mercy of demons and cannot be used by God to heal or show His power or to demonstrate that Jesus and The Kingdom of God are real! This makes Christianity a very dull religion indeed.

What follows are what Christians should be doing. It was commanded of all His followers and not just the Apostles. The verses are as follows:

"Mat 28:19-20 (AV) Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: {teach: or, make disciples, or, Christians of all nations} Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

Mark 16:15-18 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Luke 22.19 And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me. (Note this meal was to be a remembrance and not a ritual based on a cup of wine and some bread)

Luke 24:46-47 And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day: And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

Jn15:12 This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you.

Act 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

A summary of what His follower should do is as follows:

They will teach all Nations about Jesus and His Gospel

They will preach repentance and remission of sins in Jesus Name

They will witness to Jesus in all the world

They will baptise people in the Name of the Trinity

They will teach people what Jesus requires of them

Showing the signs promised by Jesus to those whom used His delegated authority (all His followers that were in the upper room and not just the apostles so there is no excuse):

They shall cast out demons

They shall speak in new tongues

They shall capture serpents and scorpions (demons)

They will drink poisons and these will not hurt them

They shall heal the sick

They will love others as Jesus loves them

They will fellowship together and remember what Jesus what Jesus did at Calvary when they eat together (have communion).

They will minister and be empowered by The Holy Spirit

These are the marks that should be a part of the Christian life. Any Christian not living them is not following Jesus and what He commanded unless they are teaching them, learning about them, learning how to put these things in to practice or resting from the battle.

Any fellowship, church or denomination not doing them is not doing what Jesus commanded. If they deliberately do not do these things then they are not Christian as they are not obeying Jesus.

Modern Bibles imply some of these things are not from Jesus but from man's writings so churches do not teach these things and so only do less than half of what Jesus commanded. Unfortunately, modern bibles are based on Greek codices that are proven forgeries so should not be used for Bible study or any Christian teaching in view of how much they leave out or alter. This is not told to people as there is too much prestige and money at stake if the truth comes out about the Greek texts.

You either follow Jesus or try to follow Him as Lord or you are serving another master (yourself) and by default, serving the devil. Jesus needs to be Lord of all of you do or think and not just of what you want to give Him. If you keep wholeheartedly trying to make Him lord of all then that is all that He requires as it the attitude of the heart that Jesus looks at when you do things. You may not succeed but the important things it that you wholeheartedly tried to serve Jesus in the way He desires you too.

What Jesus asks you to do in summary

1. John 13:34-35 A New Commandment

Jesus asks you to love others with the same quality of Love with which He Loves them with. In otherwords, you do all things in His Quality of Love. Non-Christians will see

you are different to them and will. See the difference is God's Love in you so that this becomes a form of witnessing to them.

2. Forgive others so God can forgive you and you can go to heaven.
3. Tell others about:
 - a. who He is
 - b. What He has done for them
 - c. What He is doing for them now
 - d. What He will do for them after they die
 - e. Redemption and how it allows them to have a vital, intimate, personal relationship with God
4. Demonstrate that He, His Kingdom, and Satan are real by using the Authority has delegated to you.
5. Tell them about the relationship they have with The Father and Jesus when they become Christians and teach them how to live, develop and maintain these relationships.
6. Tell them that earth is the preparation area to prepare you to be with Him in heaven and if you do not follow Jesus you go to hell.
7. How Jesus has changed your life.
8. We need to pursue holiness and be a good steward of all He has given us.

It takes faith and Lordship to live the Christian life and Jesus said we need to pursue holiness and be a good steward of all He has given us

Note that they concentrate on the reconciliation of people to the relationship mankind had with God before rebellion.

A simple explanation of The Gospel

What follows is how Jesus showed me to present The Gospel.

The Gospel is usually presented as a theological statement about what Jesus did at Calvary and comes across legalistically - obey Jesus as Lord or go to hell, and by this hides the love of God behind it.

This is the good news that the Father transfers you from the kingdom of darkness (hell) to the Kingdom of light (heaven, The Kingdom of God) when you make Jesus Lord of your life.

This is the good news of what Jesus did by His death at Calvary. He broke the barriers separating God from us so that we could once again enter into an intimate, personal, relationship with each member of The Trinity

People say that the book of Romans is about the Gospel of Salvation but it is not. His discussion on salvation is only used by Paul to show us why we need redemption (Rom 3:24, 8:1-23) and also to show us the role The Holy Spirit in our lives after we are redeemed by God (Rom 8:9, 14, 16, 26).

What follows is a simple explanation of the Gospel from the perspective of God's love for us being the reason He sent Jesus to redeem us. Jesus loved us so much He willingly went to the cross for us.

The Gospel is an expression of God's Love so Jesus told me to present it emphasising His Love for us, His children.

A simple explanation of the Gospel

God created the universe and filled it with angels to serve Him

He looked around at the Angels and said to himself I have all these angels to serve me but I have no friends So He created a beautiful park called Eden and placed in it two people He created called Adam and Eve

He loved them and treated them as His Children because He gave them life. He would visit them after they had finished their days work and spend time socialising with them. But they disobeyed Him and by this rebelled against Him.

He was King of all creation and when you rebel against a king The punishment is execution (death) or exile from the kingdom.

Because of their rebellion they were exiled from the Garden and ended up in the land ruled by God's enemy, Satan.

The relationship with God was broken. they had lost their Personal, intimate relationship with God,

No matter what mankind did They could not meet the necessary requirements for the barrier between them and God to be removed.

So God realised He had to do something to remove that barrier. So He came down as Jesus and taught us how God wanted us to live in an intimate, personal, relationship with Him then died at Calvary to meet God's requirements to remove the barrier stopping us from having a personal, intimate, relationship with God.

So the Gospel (Good News) of what Jesus did is that at Calvary He removed every barrier separating us from God so that we can now approach God directly and have an intimate, personal, relationship with Him as our spiritual Father and if we live as Jesus told us too we will spend eternity with Him in the beautiful place called heaven He has created for us to live in with Him.

Gospel Outline

The main points of The Gospel

God made people to be His friend and to have an intimate, personal relationship with Him.

He calls them His Children as He gave them life.

In the evening, after their work He would go and spend time with them like any good parent does with their children.

The people He created first Adam and Eve rejected God's love and disobeyed Him and could no longer live with Him and so had to leave the beautiful place He had created for them to live in.

God saw that mankind could not do what was necessary to restore the relationship and that He had to do it.

He loved His children so came as Jesus to meet the requirements necessary to remove the barrier separating God from mankind so that the relationship could be restored.

This Jesus did through His death on the cross at Calvary.

Eternal life Relationships

In John 17:3 we are told that eternal life is a relationship with Jesus and The Father. Why is the Holy Spirit not mentioned?

Jesus is Lord of the universe and The Father is Lord of the family of God. There is nothing else for The Holy Spirit to rule. But He has a very important role though and you need to have a correct relationship with Him to be able to be guided by Him to live as God requires you to live to carry out the other two relationships so you will get to heaven.

The relationship with Jesus as your Lord occurs when you are saved and become a citizen of The Kingdom of God.

When you are redeemed, you are able to enter heaven and enter into a relationship with Your Father in heaven.

This is why there are two relationships to eternal life. There are two sets of obedience to obey – citizen of The Kingdom of God and adopted child of The Father – so there are two relationships to develop.

The part of The Holy Spirit is to be a guide to people to be able to live as these relationships require. This is why you must be led (guided) by The Holy Spirit in all you do.

The world around you is ruled by Satan and its purpose is to lead you away from these relationships with God so The Holy Spirit has been given to guide you to avoid the snares the world places in front of you.

These relationships are necessary because The Christian life is an expression of these relationships being correctly observed and expressed in your life. The Holy Spirit is the counsellor God has given to us to guide us and you ignore a wise counsellor to your hurt.

So, you need to learn how to carry out these three relationships which are not taught by the church because Satan has subtly guided preaching so that they do not teach:

How to live as a citizen of The Kingdom of God

How to live as an adopted child of The Father

How to clearly hear The Holy Spirit as you go through your daily life.

Learning these things should be a priority in your daily life if you desire to go to heaven.

Because of what Jesus did at Calvary, mankind can once again be God's friend and have an intimate, personal relationship with Him.

God desires. you to be His friend and does all He can to help you in this. In fact, salvation results from this intimate personal relationship.

It is up to decide to have a personal relationship with God and go to be with Him in heaven or not to have one and go to hell where His enemy will torment you forever.

Evangelism

Perhaps one of the most important activity a Christian can do is evangelism.

Evangelism should be a natural result of your love for The Father and Jesus and for the lost children of The Father.

If you love them as He does, you will do what you can so that they will have the same relationship with them that you have.

So, you just always be ready to tell others of God's Love for them and what He has done and can do for them.

The main purpose of Jesus was to reconcile people to God by removing the barriers separating them from God so that they could have constant fellowship with The Father and Him

The purpose of evangelism is to do this so it is a mirror of the main purpose of Jesus.

The other purpose of Jesus was to show us what God an intimate, personal relationship with us so to just evangelize and not teach how to live as a Christian in the intimate relationship God desires with each one of us or not help someone to do this does only half the purpose of why Jesus came to earth!

So, what is evangelism?

Evangelism is telling people what God has done for you, is doing for you and can do for them if they follow Jesus as their Lord and showing by your life how He has done this for you.

If you love others as God love them then you will gladly tell them about what Jesus has done for them.

If you are a child of The Father, you will do the family business which is evangelism and discipling.

You need to know what The Gospel is to be able to tell people about it.

There are two Gospels:

The Gospel of **Salvation** that gains you entry to heaven and removes you from the danger of hell

The Gospel of Christ which is the **redemption** He obtained for us through His death that removed the defilement of sin that stopped us getting into heaven so that a salvation relationship could be entered into.

You need to explain what God has done for them and why salvation is a relationship and you need to explain what that relationship is as well as how they enter into and maintain this salvation relationship.

You are hypocrite if you have salvation and experience God's Love and do not tell others of His Love for them and His desire to enter into an intimate relationship with them because the only reason God made mankind was to enter into an intimate relationship with Him and show His Perfect Love to us.

The Gospel is about God's Love so to emphasize hell is wrong. We are to warn them about hell but not use it as a stick or the reason to become a Christian. But admittedly it is a good incentive to not sin.

You also need to know how to evangelize. In other words, the ways and methods to evangelize.

Methods of evangelism:

- All forms of visual media
- Printing (such as tracts)
- Personal Evangelism
- Witnessing by your life
- Casual conversation
- Any way God tells you to do it

Every Christian can witness in some way.

All they have to do tell what Jesus has done for you and is doing now in their life and what He has saved them from including hell then tell them that Jesus can do it for them now and after their death. It also testifies that He and His Kingdom are real.

If you have nothing to tell about how Jesus is working in your life then I would be very concerned.

To show Jesus is real you need to use His authority delegated to you over Satan and his workings to show Jesus and His Kingdom is real otherwise you may as well be any other religion who has Christian values but do not demonstrate these things.

Jesus said:

Mar 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe: In my name shall they cast out demons; they shall speak in new languages;

If you believe in who Jesus is you will cast out demons and command healing of the sick. This is a sign of a person who believes Jesus is Lord of all and who is doing His work.

Demons have to leave immediately when commanded to do so in the Name of Jesus but sickness is healed in God's timing and not ours.

We are to be always ready to

We are to be always ready to evangelize or explain things about Christianity when God give us the opportunity too and not just go to a person and preach to them.

2 Tim 4 :4(ERV) Tell everyone God's message. Be ready at all times to do whatever is needed. Tell people what they need to do, tell them when they are doing wrong, and encourage them. Do this with great patience and careful teaching.

God is their judge and not us

God is their judge and not us and so we only tell what God says and do no more except answer any questions they have or explain anything we need too to them.

We may not like what they do but we are to love in the same way The Father loves them.

But we must always be ready for when God gives us the opportunity and must know what we are to say or teach which means we must have studied it which means we also have a responsibility to learn about evangelism and matters relating to it.

If you are a good steward

If you are a good steward for the things of God then stewardship of evangelism will be in place otherwise it may be embarrassing when you approach Jesus and are judged and He asked what you did for Him as a steward of evangelism.

The Family Business

The Lord Jesus said to me:

“You have been adopted by The Father in heaven.

You are part of His family as is every other Christian who has been adopted by The Father.

All these Christians, are in a sense, relatives to be treated as such.

You also must look after the interests of this family as dictated by The Father of it in heaven.

If you love Him as a family member then your purposes will be His purposes and all you do will be an expression of the love relationship you have with Him.

This means the Christian life is an expression of this family relationship serving the family and its needs and purposes.

The purpose of this family business is the reconciliation of everyone with The Father and Jesus by rescuing them from the enemy and training them how to live as The Father desires His family members to live.

As a member of His family these too should be your purposes.

So, are they your purposes?

Do you live as part of God’s family or do you ignore this fact?

The true Christian will be doing their part, whatever God has told them it is, for the work of the family head which is The Father, once they realise the relationship, they are in. If they do not do the Will (Work) of The Father, they do not acknowledge Him as head of the family so do not belong to it or His Kingdom.

So, are you part of God’s family doing the type of family work which God has asked you to do?

Not all are called to be evangelists but all are called to demonstrate the Authority of Jesus over Satan and to be able to tell all who desire to know what Jesus and The Father has done for them.

The Christian life is the expression of the love relationship you have with other members of this family.”

Jesus

The church

The true church is made up of people who have an intimate personal relationship with the Father and the Lord Jesus guided by the Holy Spirit whom out of love for them tell others what the Father The lord Jesus and the Holy Spirit has done for them is doing for them now and will do for them in the future and in eternity so that others can have the same intimate, personal, relationship that they have which is what eternal life is with all the benefits now and in eternity they that they will have as a result of this intimate Personal relationship with The Father and The Lord Jesus under the guidance of the Holy spirit

Whatever The Father asks them to do- whether it be working, relaxing, studying, teaching, or telling others what The Father has done for them, they do this willingly as they know it is what is best for them.

The church is the family of God

In the spiritual family of God there is no division into denominations or other types of classification. It is one body unified by the presence of The Holy Spirit in the spirit of everyone.

So, every Christian is a relative as a result of adoption of them by The Father so they are either your step-brother or step-sister and to treat them otherwise is to deny they belong to The Body of the church.

Every non-Christian is also a child of The Father but is an estranged one, not adopted into the spiritual family of God as they have rejected Jesus, the entrance to this family,

The business of this family is the reconciliation of people to The Father and to their obedience to Jesus as their Lord maintaining these relationships so that they too live as adopted children of The Father with all the benefits these have.

Every Christian who Wholeheartedly obeys Jesus as the Lord is a spiritual child of The Father and are spiritual step. brother or spiritual step sister to every other true Christian

There is only one true church which is made up of all the spiritual children of the father.

United, this body of people would have won the world for Jesus, which is what will happen in the Millennium

Satan knew this unity could do so set up a strategy to disunite Christians. He did this through the use of denomination and sects. Each claimed they were the true Church and majored on protecting and developing their denomination or Sect. He turned the attention of Christians from God's true church and the Kingdom of God, to a man-made organisation and so subverted the direction of Christianity, destroying the unity of the family, of all those adopted by The Father.

Only on this true unity and focus on the Kingdom and the things of God will true revival occur as denominational boundaries are removed and the from shifts from the denomination and its purpose to those of God and His Kingdom.

Ecc 5:2-5 Be not rash with thy mouth, and let not thine heart be hasty to utter anything before God: for God is in heaven, and thou upon earth: therefore let thy words be

few. For a dream cometh through the multitude of business; and a fool's voice is known by multitude of words. When thou vowest a vow unto God, defer not to pay it; for he hath no pleasure in fools: pay that which thou hast vowed. Better is it that thou shouldest not vow, than that thou shouldest vow and not pay.

Matt 12:36 It is not what you say that matters but also what you deliberately do not say

Mat 12:36 But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.

Mat 12:37 For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.

Judgment is terrible for hypocrisy

*Heb_10:31 It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.
A Hypocrite shall not come before Him*

It is disobedience for you not to obey God or to ignore His requirements.

Luk_6:46 And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?

You must give reasons to God why you did not do His Will

Rom 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.

Judgment is certain

Heb 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

Fear is not an excuse for disobedience.

Rev_21:8 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

Note what Jesus did:

Year 1 He proved He was the Messiah

Year 2 He trained His disciples

Year 3 He sent them out to make disciples

Paul's example 2 Tim 2:2

Trained Timothy

Sent Timothy out to train others

The followers of Jesus were not sent out to train qualified people for a denomination to use to do the work on behalf of most of the other followers but to train people to do the work themselves.

Jesus sent us out to Proclaim the Gospel and train His followers to do the same.

He did not send them out to train ministers, evangelists, or counsellor but followers who knew The Gospels and Bible not denominational guidelines and textbook and who were able to disciple others.

Note

God does not expect you to do this alone which is why He expects you to train the congregation to be able to also do His Will so that you can encourage one another and support one another.

A warning

In Revelation 3:5 we are told that you can lose your salvation through lukewarmness or indifference to what you know Jesus requires you to do. He has clearly shown you are to make disciples and not just church qualified workers or denomination members.

If this is not your objective in ministering then you are possible falling under the lukewarm category as you could not be ignorant of this requirement because you would have discussed these in the theology school you attended.

So, you will be asked by Jesus, when you meet Him, how many people did you disciple for Him and carry out His work?

Remember! I am not your judge. Jeus is!

I am just passing onto you what He has said in His Bible so not to do it is to ignore Him. For this you will need to explain to Him why you did not do His Will when you face Him after you die.
