1	The Gospel of God's Love	The Gospel. how The Holy Spirit explained it to me.  It is an expression of God's Love and not a legalistic 'obey god or go to hell''
2	There are two Gospels	There are two Gospels that are pivotal to the Christian life
3	The Gospel of Salvation	The Gospel of Salvation, when The Father transfers you from the kingdom of Satan (which is hell) to His Kingdom (which is in 'heaven)  You become a citizen of The Kingdom of God and not a member of a denomination but you might attend one for fellowship and mentoring.
4	The Gospel of Redemption	The Gospel of Redemption, Where Jesus removed all that stopped you relating to Him and The Father so you could have a close, personal, relationship with Him and The Father.  .The Holy Spirit will help you live this relationship correctly.
5	What is eternal life	We are told Eternal life results from a close, personal, relationship with The Father and Jesus and Redemption removes all the barriers create by your rebellion (deliberate sin) against God!  But you must follow God's guidelines for this and have Jesus as your Lord.
6	Friends with God	God's original purpose in creating mankind was to have a close, personal, relationship with him and so He built a beautiful place for them to live in, just like any parent would do for their Child
7	God spent time with them	After Adam finished their days work God would visit them and spend time with them like any parent would with their child.

8	Mankind sinned (rebelled)	But man, deliberately disobeyed God ( which is what sin is) and so was cast out into a world controlled by God's enemy, Satan.
9	Every sin has a penalty	There was a penalty to be paid as a result of man sinning and God saw that mankind could not pay it
10	Why Jesus came	God loved His children and saw He would have to remove the penalty and other consequences of sin, so He sent Jesus (who is God) who came to teach us how to live in a correct, personal, relationship with God and who died to remove all the consequences of our rebellion that stopped us entering God's Kingdom.
11	God does all He can to help you	God has done all He can to help you become a child of His and does all He can to help you live in a close relationship With Him so that you will spend eternity with Him heaven
12	The choice is y ours	Conclusion  You can either have a relationship with God and eternal life or be tormented forever in the kingdom of His enemy who hates people and torments them mercilessly.
